Ghana, Shining Star of Africa

Ghana, which has achieved a significant growth rate in the economy in recent years, especially in international relations are strengthening rapidly after the 2000s. In particular, the United Nations Secretary General Kofi Annan, who was with the accelerated opening to the world in Ghana, the current period is among the countries that are most talked of African countries. Also in 2008, the African football finals held in Ghana and all the world media has remained on the agenda because it is successfully carried out for about 1 month and gave very significant signs of improvement

The agriculture sector in Ghana, is still the main sectors of the economy, the contribution of agriculture to GDP is around 35%. Services sector has a share of around 30% of GDP, 25% of the contribution of industry to GDP is 10% of the evaluation of the mining and oil sectors in the industry. Ghana's GDP has shown significant improvement in recent years. In the year 2011 with 7.7% of GDP in 2010 and 14.4% as at record levels.

The services sector accounts for 30% of GDP. Services are operating with the largest sub-sector of banking services provided by the government sector. That tourism, retail, restaurant and hotel management are followed. Telecommunications sector has begun to grow in importance within. Industrial sectors in the food processing industry, beverages, tobacco, textiles, garments, footwear, wood, chemicals and aluminum industries is the main installation industries in the country with the cosmetic industry and steel industry, the most important place they hold. While this was initially established by the state of the industry today, mostly all were privatized. Contribution to GDP is the most important gold mining activities in the mining sector at the level of 5-6%

The presence of oil in 2007 and started to export in 2010, Ghana's economy and GAMA (Greater Accra Metropolitan Area) enlivened the African region 11.büyük. Oil of Ghana's economy has helped to grow 8.7% in the last five years. Private consumption expenditures increased 7.5%. The country's growing middle class has attracted many international brands to the retail center. This indicates that the shopping trends of westernization. Ghana Looking forward, I believe the demographic structure over the next 25 years would be an incredible window in this sector. According to the report of the United Nations working age population it is projected to rise to 64.8% in 2040 from 57.5% in 2010. At the same time, in particular to increase the income distribution dynamics. Low-income today than 60% share of Ghana, is expected to fall to 20% in 2030. This is the end of the next 15 years, the middle section and the upper section of the lower 20% and is expected to

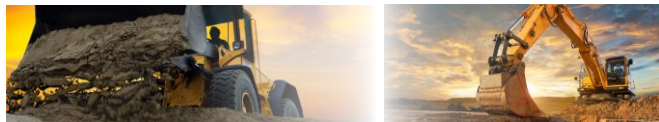
